

LEATHER & VINYL RECOLORING BALM INSTRUCTIONS

WHAT'S IN YOUR REPAIR KIT?

- 8.5 oz (250ml) jar of recoloring balm
- one-size-fits-all gloves
- 2 microfiber cloths (1 for application, 1 for buffing)
- detailing brush

Before You Start: If there are any large cracks, tears, or holes, repair the damaged areas first with Coconix Professional Leather and Vinyl Repair Kit. Shallow surface damages or peeling can be repaired by applying multiple layers of recoloring balm with the detailing brush, but a specialized repair kit is required for larger damages.



Step 1: Cleaning

Before applying the recoloring balm, clean the damaged area using rubbing alcohol. Test on an inconspicuous spot first. If alcohol removes your leather's color, use water and a small amount of mild soap or your usual leather/vinyl cleaner instead.



Step 2: Balm Application

Put on the included gloves and use the red microfiber cloth to apply the balm in one direction and as evenly as possible to avoid streaks. Apply thin layers and wait for each layer to dry before adding layers.



Step 3: Surface Damages

If your upholstery has shallow surface damages or peeling, apply the recoloring balm with the detailing brush to blend in the uneven spots. Continue adding layers, until the surface is fully even.



Step 4: Drying

Allow several hours for the recoloring balm to dry until it is fully dried. Once dry, apply additional layers as desired.



Step 5: Buffing

Use the blue microfiber cloth for buffing. Apply some elbow grease to even out the balm's thick consistency.

TROUBLESHOOTING

■ The color of the balm does not match my leather or vinyl

The balm is not suitable for spot repairs like faded or stained spots, as there is no color-matching option. Its purpose is to recolor the whole upholstery.

■ The area to be recolored has damages

If the area has shallow surface damage and peeling, apply multiple layers of leather recoloring balm using the detailing brush. For larger cracks, tears, and holes, you will need to spot-repair them first with Coconix Professional Leather and Vinyl Repair Kit.

■ I am not sure which microfiber cloth to use on my project

Your box includes two microfiber cloths: the red one is for balm application and the blue one is for buffing.

I made a mistake and want to start over

You can start over with your recoloring project by firmly rubbing the areas with a wet cloth or sponge damp with hot soapy water. If the recoloring balm is dry, use rubbing alcohol and a cloth to carefully remove the balm. Please test it in an inconspicuous area and proceed with care.

■ I need a shiny finish

For a shiny finish, we recommend applying leather or vinyl conditioner. Most conditioners with leather or vinyl protectors will restore the finish and can be applied directly to the treated area.

■ The recolored area feels sticky

The drying time of the recoloring balm depends on the thickness of the layer and the relative humidity of the environment. For best results, apply thin layers and let the recoloring balm dry fully between each layer. If your project is still sticky after 2-3 days, carefully rub the repaired area with a cotton pad and high concentration (90+%) rubbing alcohol. Before applying the rubbing alcohol, please test on an inconspicuous area and proceed with care.
